Knowledge and Experience

- This position requires a high school degree or GED, plus one year's experience in a landscaping or hardscaping field.
- Candidate must be able to read and write.
- The successful individual will have a basic knowledge of standard horticultural practices. An understanding of hardscaping practices including paver, pond, low-voltage lighting, and irrigation troubleshooting, is helpful.
- Good oral communication skills, job planning skills, and mechanical aptitude are a must.
- Ability to operate a truck and trailer combination proficiently.
- Ohio Driver's License and insurable with company's agent

Work Environment

Physical Demands

The physical demands outlined are examples of the type of demands the employee will encounter on the job site.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk; crouch; stoop or kneel; reach with hands and arms; talk; and hear. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 80 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job are dictated by the Ohio Driver's License requirements.

Job Site Conditions

The job site conditions described below are examples of those conditions an employee encounters while performing the essential responsibilities of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential responsibilities.

While performing the duty of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, outside weather (heat or cold), and moving mechanical equipment.

In addition, job sites are located on both residential and commercial property. The employee may also occasionally be exposed to the homeowner's pets.
